

Planting Mediterranean Trees

Step 1: Dig a hole 6 inches deeper and 8 inches wider than the root ball of the tree.

Step 2: Put the supplied hydro grains at the bottom of the hole and divide these evenly.

Step 3: Put 2 inches of the supplied Mediterranean substrate on top of the hydro grains.

Step 4: Remove the tree from of the container and scrape the root ball carefully with a shovel.

Step 5: Rest the root ball on the Mediterranean substrate.

Step 6: Spread the remaining Mediterranean substrate against the root ball.

Step 7: Finish the surface some garden soil or potting soil.

Step 8: Water the tree at least 5 minutes with a water hose. Even if the soil is moist at the time of planting, thoroughly irrigate the tree to settle the soil around the root system.

Step 9: Try, as much as possible, to talk Spanish to your Mediterranean tree so that your tree feels itself at home in your garden very quickly 😊

Planting Mediterranean Trees into a planter.

Step 1: Put 6 inches of the supplied hydro grains at the bottom of the planter.

Step 2: Put 2 inches of the supplied Mediterranean substrate on top of the hydro grains.

Step 3: Remove the tree from of the container and scrape the root ball carefully with a shovel.

Step 4: Plant the tree in the planter.

Step 5: Spread the remaining Mediterranean substrate against the root ball.

Step 6: Finish the surface some garden soil or potting soil.

Step 7: Water the tree at least 5 minutes with a water hose.
